

Parasite Tendency Research Test

We believe in the accuracy of this self-test, but we make it available only as a research tool with no guarantee of success or accuracy as a diagnostic tool. Years ago, we would send participants who tested positive to an outside laboratory that specialized in stool testing for parasites and heavy metals. There was a strong correlation between our Parasite Tendency Research Reagent and positive results obtained at the lab - so much so, that we stopped sending specimens to the lab and simply relied on this research test.

It is simple to use. Simply put 1" of urine into the test tube that is provided. Then, add 7 drops of the *Parasite Tendency Research* reagent. If the mix curdles, the test may be considered positive and the participant should consider further lab testing for parasites.

If there is a purple color at the bottom of the test tube, the participant should consider further testing for the presence of heavy metals in their system.
